Merry Christmas!! This evening we begin our celebration of Christmas with our Christmas Vigils at 4pm and 6pm, and over the next 8 days we celebrate the Octave of Christmas. The Octave of Christmas ends on the Feast Day of Mary, the Mother of God (January 1st). Of course, we celebrate Christmas Day in a special way, it being the day we commemorate the birth of Jesus Christ, our Lord and Savior. After the Octave of Christmas, we continue to celebrate the Christmas Season until the celebration of the Baptism of the Lord on January 8, 2018.

Much of the world will be finished with Christmas by Tuesday morning, but we continue to celebrate the Mystery of the Incarnation for more than two weeks. Our Blessed Mother reflected on the marvel of the Incarnation in her heart (Luke 2:19). So should we. Let us take advantage of the full season of Christmas in order to receive the fullness of the Grace and Peace of Christ!

### **Schedule Next Weekend**

Because January 1st falls on Monday, it is not a holy day of obligation this year. Therefore, next weekend our Mass schedule will be the same as usual, that is, 4pm Saturday Vigil and 8am, 10am and 5pm Sunday. Mass for January 1st, the Solemnity of Mary, Mother of God, will be at 9am.

## Christmas Message on Reception of Holy Communion

Welcome to all, and Merry Christmas! Christmas is such a wonderful and joyous time. One of the reasons for this joy is that our church is more filled with worshippers, both Catholic and non-Catholic, to marvel at the mystery of The Incarnation, when God Himself became flesh and dwelt among us! This coming together of so many to worship God is a wonderful thing to see and experience.

With so many new worshippers present and others who may not be Catholic, it may be helpful to recall what is necessary to receive Holy Communion at Mass. Following the dictates of Sacred Scripture (1 Cor 11:27), the Church teaches that one should be properly disposed before receiving Holy Communion. In order to be properly disposed to receive Holy Communion, one must be Catholic and, after a reflective examination, not aware of having committed grave or serious sin. If a Catholic has committed grave or serious sin, then Sacramental Confession should be made prior to reception of Holy Communion. One such serious sin is the failure to worship God by missing Mass on any Sunday or holy day of obligation without a serious reason.

If one is not Catholic or is a Catholic not properly disposed to receive Holy Communion, please feel welcome to come forward and receive a blessing from the Minister of Communion. If one wants to receive a blessing, then simply let the minister know by placing your index finger over your mouth or crossing your arms over your chest.
