CENTENNIAL NEWS

- Holy Rosary Institute is Blessed - On April 26, 1914, four years before the Diocese of Lafayette was created, Archbishop Blenk of New Orleans blessed the newly built structure of Holy Rosary Institute. The school was made possible by the work of Fr. Philip Keller and the financial support of St. Katharine Drexel, who donated \$10,500 to build the new school for African American young women. The school would be operated by the Sisters of the Holy Family, an African American Religious Order founded by Mother Henriette Delille. In 1947, the school began admitting male students. Holy Rosary Institute was closed in 1993, after almost 80 years of service in education.
- Centennial Indulgence – an indulgence granted by Pope Francis can be gained throughout this Centennial Year by all who visit our Cathedral of St. John the Evangelist and pray the Centennial Prayer (with the usual conditions for an indulgence).
